_____	_____	Senior Camper is coming to camp to have fun but understands that there will be some additional responsibilities expected of him/her in their role as Senior Camper.
_____	_____	Senior Camper has chosen to participate in this program, and by doing so has been given a reduced camp fee. This reduced fee does require camper to participate in a minimum of 72 program hours during the regular camp day (8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.), along with adhering to the program requirements listed in this contract.
_____	_____	Senior Camper agrees to attend at least two in-camp days (Monday, Wednesday, or Thursday) of Week One (June 21st-25th). If he/she is unable to do so, you will need to contact Parks and Recreation to apply for an exemption from this requirement.
_____	_____	Senior Camper is expected to be courteous, friendly, and respectful to all other campers/senior campers, recognizing that this is a key component to being a strong leader and team member.
_____	_____	Senior Camper is expected to deal with problems with other campers in a safe, calm manner and will make every effort to resolve issues in a mature and respectful way.
_____	_____	Senior Camper understands that social cruelty (bullying, teasing, sarcasm and criticism or words that are intended to be a “put down”) will not be tolerated.
_____	_____	Senior Camper understands that there is a zero-tolerance policy for any type of physical violence (hitting, fighting, restraining, etc.).
_____	_____	Senior Camper agrees to be involved in the planning and implementation of either one special event for the younger campers during the course of the summer, and/or at least one community service project. Camper will have the opportunity to provide input regarding what type(s) of special events and/or community service projects will be accomplished.
_____	_____	Senior Camper understands that any disciplinary action taken regarding violation of any camp rules may result in loss of senior camper status ; Camp discount will no longer apply and parent will be required to pay a prorated fee in order to keep camper in camp for remainder of summer.
