Please note: ALL field trips are included in the cost of attending camp and are only offered to campers. No separate registration is necessary.

Field Trip Policies

- Please note: Although we will do our best to adhere to the planned field trip schedule, trips may be subject to change due to weather.
- Weekly newsletters will be sent home with detailed information about each field trip.
- Campers must arrive at camp no later than 9:00 am on Field Trip days.
- A lunch must be brought on all field trip days, even on days when field trip destinations may have snacks available.
- Campers need to bring a bathing suit, towel, sunscreen, a change of clothes, and water bottle on water trips.
- Camp shirts are required clothing on Field Trip days. One camp shirt will be provided; additional shirts may be purchased during registration.
- Departure and return times may vary with traffic and distance.
- Ranger & Adventure Camps ONLY: Extra spending money for field trips may be permitted.

Swim Lessons

Grades: K-8

Dates: Wednesdays, 6 weeks beginning July 5th

Times: 1:00pm-3:00pm

Fee: \$65 for children enrolled in camp; \$75 all others

Location: St. Joseph's College Alford Center

Held at St. Joseph's College, this is a six-week program for all swim levels, with transportation provided for kids enrolled in camp. The first week of lessons will include a swimming evaluation to insure that your child receives appropriate instruction for his/her swimming level. All participants must keep long hair tied back, and no outdoor shoes may be worn in the pool area.



Zumba for Kids

Grades: K-2

Dates: Wednesdays, 5 weeks beginning July 5th

Times: 10:00am-10:45am

Fee: \$30 for children enrolled in camp; \$50 all other Windham residents/\$60 non-residents

Location: Windham Primary School Gym

This class will feature kid-friendly Zumba routines, with plenty of movement and upbeat music! Instructor Sheila Payne will break down the moves to make them easy to learn prior to putting on the music to dance. Your child will have a great time dancing, and get plenty of exercise at the same time! All participants should wear comfortable clothing and shoes that allow for a full range of movement.

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Cycling Club



Grades: 3-5

Dates: Mondays, 4 weeks beginning July 10th

Times: 10:00am-12:00pm, July 31 10:00am-2:00pm

Fee: \$25 for children enrolled in camp; \$55 all other Windham residents/\$65 non-residents

Location: Trips depart from and return to Windham Middle School

This four-week program will feature bike excursions on area trails as well as cycling safety workshops. Participants must bring their own bicycle and appropriately-fitting bike helmet to camp; for some outings, Parks and Recreation staff will transport participants and their bicycles to the trailhead. Each week's excursion will include a snack provided by camp counselors, and all participants will receive a water bottle.

Paddling Adventure

Grades: 3-8

Dates: Thursdays, 4 weeks beginning June 29th

Times: 9:30am-11:30am, July 20th 10:00am-2:00pm

Fee: \$95 for children enrolled in camp; if space permits, non-campers may enroll after May 26th for \$120 per person

Location: Trips depart from and return to Windham Middle School

Join instructors from Sebago Trails Paddling Co. to explore local ponds and rivers by kayak. No previous kayaking experience is necessary. Participants will learn paddling skills and enjoy time on the water. This program will culminate in a paddling trip through the Songo Locks for the final session on July 20th.

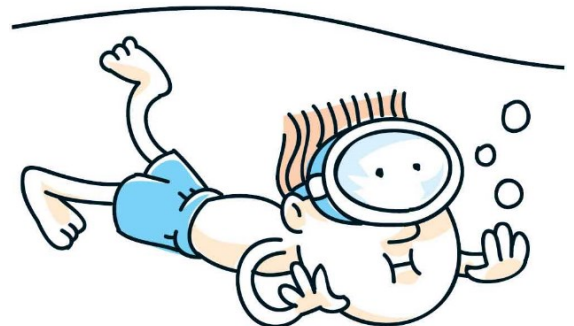
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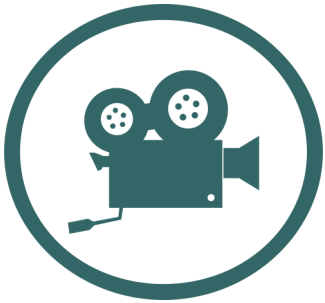

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Adventure Camp

Grades 6-8

Overnight Trips

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Adventure Bound Whitewater Rafting

Grades: 6-8

Dates: July 12th-13th

Times: Depart at 12:00pm on July 12th, return at 6:00pm on July 13th

Fee: \$75 deposit

This overnight trip to Adventure Bound in Caratunk, ME includes a night of camping at the Adventure Bound Youth Center followed by day of whitewater rafting on the Kennebec River! Licensed whitewater rafting guides will take the group down the river, and activities at Adventure Bound include an indoor climbing wall, a swimming pool and hot tub, sand volleyball courts, and more.

Please note, the actual cost of this trip is \$160 per participant. However, Windham Parks & Recreation will be offering fundraising opportunities throughout the summer as part of the day camp program to help offset the remaining cost of the trip beyond the \$75 deposit. Fundraisers may include a local car wash, bake sale at Windham Town Hall, concessions at Dundee Park, and more. Each trip attendee will be required to participate in **at least one** fundraiser; otherwise he/she will be responsible for paying the full \$160 cost of the trip.

All participants must be enrolled in at least TWO weeks of summer camp.



Dundee Park Campout

Grades: 6-8

Dates: July 25th-26th (rain date August 8th-9th)

Fee: \$25, must be enrolled in camp for Week 5

When the camp day ends, the campout begins! Adventure Camp staff will provide transportation to Dundee Park, where we will cook dinner, swim and relax on the beach, and play outdoor games. All group camping gear, including tents and cooking stoves, will be provided by Windham Parks & Recreation. Participants will need to bring their own sleeping bags and overnight necessities. We will return to WMS in time to participate in camp activities on Wednesday morning.
