Grades: K-8


Dates: Wednesdays, 6 weeks beginning June 27th (no class 7/4)



#### **Swim Lessons**

Grades: K-8

Dates: Wednesdays, 6 weeks beginning June 27th (no class 7/4)

Fee: \$70 for children enrolled in camp; \$80 all others

Location: St. Joseph's College Alfond Center

Held at St. Joseph's College, this is a six-week program for all swim levels, with transportation provided for kids enrolled in camp. The first week of lessons will include a swimming evaluation to insure that your child receives appropriate instruction for his/her swimming level. All participants must keep long hair tied back, and no outdoor shoes may be worn in the pool area.

# **Grades 6-9 Overnight Trips**

Please note: Overnight trips are an add-on to the day camp program, and are only offered to children who are enrolled in camp.

You must register and pay separately for these activities.

#### **Dundee Park Campout**

Grades: 6-9

Dates: July 24th-25th (rain date August 7th-8th) Fee: \$30, must be enrolled in camp for Week 5

When the camp day ends, the campout begins! Adventure Camp staff will provide transportation to Dundee Park, where we will cook dinner, swim and relax on the beach, and play outdoor games. All group camping gear, including tents and cooking stoves, will be provided by Windham Parks & Recreation. Participants will need to bring their own sleeping bags and overnight necessities. We will return to WMS in time to participate in camp activities on Wednesday morning.



**Adventure Bound Whitewater Rafting** 

Grades: 6-9

Dates: August 13th-15th

Times: Depart at 10:00am on August 13th, return at approximately 12:00pm on August 15th

Fee: \$100 deposit

This two-night trip to Adventure Bound in Caratunk, ME includes two nights of camping and activities at the Adventure Bound Youth Center as well as a full day of whitewater rafting on the Kennebec River! Licensed whitewater rafting guides will take the group down the river, and activities at Adventure Bound include an indoor climbing wall, a swimming pool and hot tub, sand volleyball courts, and more.

Please note, the actual cost of this trip is ~\$185 per participant. However, Windham Parks & Recreation will be offering fundraising opportunities throughout the summer as part of the day camp program to help offset the remaining cost of the trip beyond the \$100 deposit. Fundraisers may include an evening of concessions at Dundee Park, a local car wash, a bake sale at day camp, and more. Each trip attendee will be required to participate in at least one fundraiser; otherwise he/she will be responsible for paying the full \$185 cost of the trip.

All participants must be enrolled in at least TWO weeks of summer camp. There will be an informational meeting for parents and participants prior to the August 13th departure.
